Speech

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Speech is designed to introduce a student to public speaking and to develop his/her ability to speak in front of an audience with confidence and poise. To achieve these purposes, students will learn to develop the mechanics of Kinesics (body language) and facial expression. Students will be given the opportunity to improve their listening, speech, and communication skills with a focus on organization, articulation, delivery, and relaxation. How to establish and maintain correct eye contact, how to move purposefully, and how to maintain poise and self-control are all focal points of the course. This course meets all Academic Content Standards outlined by benchmarks and indicators for the grade level adopted by the Ohio State Board of Education.
