Each group will create a presentation that tells the story of The Rape of the Lock by Alexander Pope. The presentation must cover details such as names, places, and historical significance. Be creative and develop a presentation that is interesting to watch, i.e. the sock puppet presentation shown in class covered the requirements well. Some suggestions for the presentation are below, but your group may develop something different. Be creative.

- Animals dressed as characters to act out the story as the group narrates.
- Chalk drawings that occur as the group narrates the story.
- Kitchen utensils dressed to be the puppets to act out the story as the group narrates.
- Marionette puppets to act out the story as the group narrates.

The presentation must be recorded and uploaded onto YouTube® and saved with the title given in class. You may select the privacy settings for the presentation on YouTube®, but be sure it can be accessed so the class will be able to view it.
